CC CANCELS GETTY/REX INQUIRY

The Competition Commission (CC) has today cancelled its inquiry into the anticipated acquisition by Getty Images, Inc of Rex Features Limited.

The CC has received assurances from Getty Images, Inc that the proposed acquisition has been abandoned.

The case was referred to the CC by the Office of Fair Trading (OFT) on 8 July 2010.

The CC had been asked to decide whether the acquisition may have been expected to result in a substantial lessening of competition within any market or markets in the UK for goods or services, including the supply of archive editorial images and live entertainment-related editorial images in the UK.

Notes for editors

1. The reference has been cancelled in accordance with the provisions of section 37(1) of the Enterprise Act 2002.
2. The CC is under a duty under section 37(1) to cancel a reference if it is satisfied that the parties have abandoned arrangements for an acquisition of the kind mentioned in the reference.
3. The Enterprise Act 2002 empowers the OFT to refer to the CC completed or proposed mergers for investigation and report which create or enhance a 25 per cent share of supply in the UK (or a substantial part thereof) or where the UK turnover associated with the enterprise being acquired is over £70 million.
