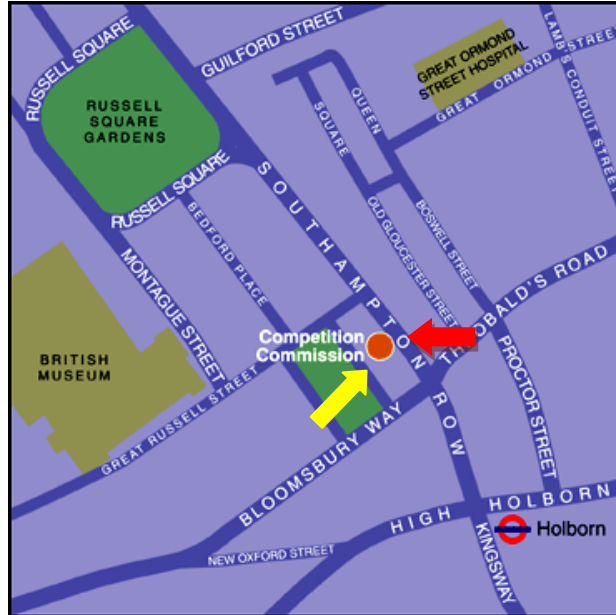

## Visiting the CC

The CC has two public entrances to Victoria House; one with step-free access (off Bloomsbury Square; the yellow arrow on the map), and one on Southampton Row (the red arrow on the map).

Visitors most often enter via the Southampton Row entrance (the building is not clearly marked, but there is a bus stop directly in front of the revolving doors).

## Step-free access

If you would prefer to use the step-free public entrance on Bloomsbury Square we can make sure Victoria House security staff know to expect you. The Bloomsbury Square entrance is accessible off Bloomsbury Way (this is a one-way street and you are looking for a cut-through between the building and the park, opposite Sicilian Avenue).

For wheelchair users, the doors at this entrance are to the left of the revolving doors and are normally kept closed for security reasons. However, if security staff are expecting a visitor who requires access they will leave the doors open. For ad-hoc or out of hours visitors there is a video entry system at the doors, including an intercom at wheelchair height.

Once in the building there is a lift to take you up to reception level. Our Facilities team will be more than happy to help you by meeting you at the entrance or offering advice on arrangements when you are visiting (Tel. 020 7271 0200).

## Reception arrangements

When you arrive at Victoria House, you will need to register with the main reception on the ground floor. They will issue you with a badge, and will direct you to the CC's second floor reception. There is clear signage to the CC reception from the second floor lift area. The CC's reception will call your host to meet you.

If you have any trouble finding or accessing the building, you can call our reception desk (020 7271 0123). Please note that you will not be able to proceed beyond reception unless you are expected for an arranged meeting and have someone to escort you.
