Further to representation given by our member Paul Saunders on the 24th March 2006 I am writing to advise that Tesco whom you are investigating (along with other store groups) is I believe using its land banks and influence to curry favour with Worcestershire County Council. Only tonight in the Worcester News page 3 the C. C. reveal that they are to build a new high school to replace the Christopher Whitehead Language College on a site owned by Tesco at Earls Court Farm Worcester. Our group will again strongly oppose any such a move.

As advised previously I believe that this disturbing case illustrates again that Tesco indulge in strategic behaviour that includes using financial inducements to alter the course of the democratic process. The whole thing stinks.
