

**COMPLETED ACQUISITION BY THE GAME GROUP PLC OF
GAMES STATION LIMITED AND ITS WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY

Competition Commission Acceptance of Revised Undertakings

IN THE MATTER of a reference to the Competition Commission dated 9 August 2007 concerning the acquisition by the Game Group Plc (“Game”) of Games Station Limited (“Games Station”).

Whereas on 9 August 2007 the Office of Fair Trading, in exercise of its duty under section 22 of the Enterprise Act 2002 (“the Act”) referred to the Competition Commission (“the CC”) the completed acquisition by Game of Games Station:
