

**REFERENCE RELATING TO THE COMPLETED ACQUISITION
BY THE GAME GROUP PLC OF GAMES STATION LIMITED**

**Notice of provisional findings made under Rule 10.3
of the Competition Commission Rules of Procedure**

1. On 9 August 2007, the Office of Fair Trading, in exercise of its duty under section 22(1) of the Enterprise Act 2002 (the Act) and its power under section 35(6) of the Act, referred to the Competition Commission (CC) the completed acquisition by The GAME group plc of Games Station Limited for investigation and report within a period ending on 23 January 2008.

Provisional findings

2. The CC inquiry group (the Group) appointed to consider this reference have made the following provisional findings on the statutory questions it has to decide pursuant to section 35(1) of the Act:
 - (a) a relevant merger situation has been created; and
 - (b) the creation of that situation has not resulted, nor may be expected to result, in a substantial lessening of competition in the markets for the supply of gaming software, consoles or peripherals in the UK.
3. The Group's reasons are set out in full in the provisional findings report, a summary of which is attached to this notice. A copy of the provisional findings report will be published on the CC website (see note below).

The next steps

4. Anyone wishing to comment on the provisional findings is now invited to provide the Group with their reasons in writing as to why these provisional findings should not become final (or, as the case may be, should be varied).
5. These reasons should be received by the Group no later than 31 December 2007.
6. The Group will have regard to any such reasons in making its final decisions on the statutory questions and actions.
