ANTICIPATED ACQUISITION BY ANGLO AMERICAN PLC OF JOHNSTON GROUP PLC

Competition Commission invites evidence

The Office of Fair Trading (OFT) has referred the anticipated acquisition by Anglo American plc (Anglo American) of Johnston Group PLC to the Competition Commission (CC). Anglo American is the parent of Tarmac Limited.

The CC has been asked to consider whether the proposed acquisition will result in a relevant merger situation and, if so, whether its creation may be expected to result in a substantial lessening of competition within the markets for aggregates and asphalt in the West Midlands, where Johnston and Tarmac operate.

The CC is expected to report by 15 March 2005.

Notes for editors

1. The Enterprise Act 2002 empowers the OFT to refer to the CC completed or proposed mergers for investigation and report which create or enhance a 25 per cent share of supply in the UK (or a substantial part thereof) or where the UK turnover associated

with the enterprise being acquired is over £70 million (see OFT Press Release PN 06/04).

2. The CC has a 24-week period in which it is required to publish its report, which may be extended by no more than eight weeks if it considers that there are special reasons why the report cannot be published within that period.
